Lacrosse on-field equipment players will need:

- Lacrosse helmet with face mask White or Black Cascade S and Cascade R are recommended and fit our helmet wraps. Please check if helmet wrap is available from Sehome Lacrosse before purchasing other models.
- Mouth guard strap on mouth guard to connect to helmet face mask is not necessary but recommended.
- Should pads/chest pad -Warrior, STX, Brine, and Maverik are the most common brands. Chest pad for goalies.
- Elbow pads size usually depends on position with defenders wearing smaller pads and attack larger. Warrior, STX, Brine, and Maverik are the most common brands.
- Lacrosse gloves MUST be majority white or black. Warrior, STX, Brine, and Maverik are the most common brands.
- Cleats Black or white are recommended. Lacrosse, football, or soccer cleats work.
 Majority of games and practice are on field turf but there may be grass fields on occasion.
- Lacrosse stick Head and shaft often specific to position but does not need to be specific. Shaft MUST have an end cap. Defenders use long shafts (52"-72"), all other players use normal (usually 40"-42"). Warrior, STX, Brine, and Maverik are the most common brands
- Athletic cup optional most players do not wear but that is your choice.
